## Rahul Gandhi should clarify, who is he aiming to please by encouraging 'Pakistan Zindabad' slogans at his rallies?

Hon'ble Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation Shri Amit Shah addressed public rallies in Tohana and Jagadhri in Haryana, on Monday. Shri Amit Shah praised Hon'ble PM Narendra Modi Ji's efforts to make Haryana a 'Viksit Haryana' while criticizing the Congress for its corruption and anti-Dalit stance. During the event, Haryana Chief Minister Shri Nayab Singh Saini, State BJP President Shri Mohan Lal Badoli, Tohana Candidate Shri Devendra Babli, Ratia Candidate Smt Sunita Duggal and Jagadhari Candidate Chaudhary Kanwar Pal Gurjar, Yamuna Nagar Candidate Shri Ghanshyam Dass Arora, Radaur Candidate Shri Shyam Singh Rana, Sadhaura candidate Shri Balwant Singh among other leaders were present.

Shri Shah began his address by paying homage to the great freedom fighter Rao Tula Ram, who played a significant role in the 1857 war. He also paid tribute to Guru Nanak Dev and Baba Banda Singh. Under BJP leadership, Tohana has achieved remarkable heights. Haryana stands as a prime example of the effective leadership of the Bharatiya Janata Party. Previously, only two parties ruled the state: one known for corruption and the other for fostering hooliganism. Casteism and familism have peaked in both parties. For the first time, the Bharatiya Janata Party has formed a complete majority government in Haryana, with full support from the state's citizens. The BJP is committed to making *'Viksit Haryana*,' having invested ₹3,700 crores to construct new roads. A total of 51 projects worth ₹47,000 crores were initiated by Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi Ji, with 30 projects valued at ₹35,000 crores currently in progress. Additionally, a Detailed Project Report worth ₹20,000 crores has been established.

Union Home Minister Shri Shah stated that prior to the BJP government, **youth in Haryana were forced to secure jobs through a** *'Kharchi-Parchi'* **system.** The BJP has put an end to this malpractice, and now thousands of youth receive appointment letters directly at their homes via post. **The Congress party is anti-Dalit**, with several tragedies occurring under its rule, such as the Gohana incident in 2005 and the Mirchpur case in 2010. The Congress also hindered access to job reservations, often citing 'not found suitable' as a reason. **Dalit leaders have often been insulted by the Congress, including figures like Ashok Tanwar and Kumari Selja.** The Congress has disrespected Baba Saheb Ambedkar, while the BJP has honored him with the Bharat Ratna. Additionally, **the BJP established** *Panch Teerth* **and designated** *'Samvidhan Diwas'* **to commemorate his legacy.** Opposition has left no stone unturned in appeasement for vote banks. Congress members opposed triple talaq and the construction of the Ram Mandir in Ayodhya. **While Rahul Gandhi speaks about scrapping reservations, Shri Nayab Singh Saini has advocated for reservations and increasing the creamy layer.** 

Shri Shah stated that recently, **Rahul Gandhi visited the USA and claimed that after development, reservations are no longer necessary and would eventually be scrapped**. Only Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi Ji can protect reservations for SC and OBC. Haryana has significantly contributed to the Indian Army, with one in ten individuals from the state serving in the army. For over four decades, army personnel have demanded One Rank One Pension (OROP), but Congress ignored this. After Shri Narendra Modi Ji became Prime Minister, he implemented OROP in 2015, and now the third version is in effect. During Congress rallies, slogans like '*Pakistan Zindabad*' were chanted from Hathin to Thansear to Palwal. The people of Haryana cannot support such leadership. Rahul Gandhi should clarify whom he aims to please by allowing such slogans at Congress events.

Shri Shah remarked that Rahul Gandhi, in alliance with the National Conference, talks about restoring Article 370 and releasing terrorists. **Even Rahul Gandhi's third generation would not be able to reinstate Article 370. Article 370 has become history.** It raised questions about Kashmir, but now Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi Ji has put an end to those questions raised because of Article 370. Until a single BJP leader is alive, we will not allow terrorism to take root in Haryana, Punjab, and Kashmir.

Union Home Minister Shri Shah stated that Congress was indulged in corruption. To please their *'Dilli Ka Damad,'* Haryana farmers' land was sold for cheap prices. **During Hooda's government, dealers, the 'Damaad,' and corrupt individuals were dominant**. However, the BJP has put an end to that government's reign. Congress promised 2 lakh jobs in their manifesto, and so does the BJP. **But who will Congress give jobs to? To deserving candidates, or through their 'Parchi Kharchi' model to the undeserving?** Voting for Congress means rampant bribery for jobs, while voting for the BJP means distributing jobs to deserving candidates, with appointment letters delivered directly to their homes. This is how the BJP runs the government. Even Congress leaders admit their government can't function without corruption. **In this election, on one side there is 'Bharosemand BJP,' while the 'corrupt Congress' on the other.** In 2013-14, under Sonia Gandhi, the budget for farmers was ₹22,000 crore. However, under the Modi government for 2024-25, the budget allocation for farmer welfare has reached ₹1,52,000 crore respectively.

Shri Shah remarked that the whole country takes pride in Sikh gurus, and every household respects Dasam Pita and Guru Nanak Dev Ji. However, **Rahul Gandhi claims in the U.S. that Sikhs lack the freedom to wear turbans**, *Kada*, and visit gurdwaras. It seems he must be living in a different India. Here, all Indians visit gurdwaras, proudly wear turbans, and bow to Guru Granth Sahib. Rahul Gandhi disrespects Indian culture on the global stage and his party has a history of disrespecting the Sikh community. During the Delhi riots, when Congress was in power, thousands of Sikhs were killed, including women and children. Rahul Gandhi should visit a gurdwara wearing a turban and apologize to the Sikh community. Whether it's disrespecting Harmandir Sahib or Sardar Manmohan Singh, the Congress party has a history of such actions.

Union Home Minister Shri Shah emphasized that in the 10 years of BJP governance, Haryana has become smoke-free, established educated panchayats and emerged as the country's largest exporter of Basmati rice. One in ten soldiers in the army hails from Haryana, 24 crops are now covered under MSP. Crops like Bajra, Jowar, pulses, and oilseeds were brought under the MSP. Congress does not even understand the full form of MSP. Bhavantar Yojana ensures

farmer welfare. Haryana was also the first to ensure 50% reservation for women in panchayats and to provide tap water access in every household. Under Congress, paddy purchases were just 4 lakh metric tons, but this has surged to 830 lakh metric tons under the BJP. Wheat purchases increased from 251 lakh metric tons to 430 lakh metric tons. The MSP for wheat was ₹1,300 during Congress and has been raised to ₹2,300 by the BJP, with plans to increase it to ₹3,100 after the elections.

Shri Shah presented that the Fatehabad district comprises three state assembly seats. In Fatehabad alone, over the past 10 years, 187 km of roads have been expanded under the PM Gram Sadak Yojana, with more than ₹75 crore invested. **Under the PM Kisan Samman Nidhi**, **over ₹200 crore has been allocated to benefit 1 lakh farmers. Additionally, 1,900 hectares of land have been added for irrigation**. Two indigenous reactors of 700 MW each have been established. More than 5.5 crore street vendors have received loans. Over 62,000 houses have been provided with water tap connections, and every household has been equipped with toilets, LPG cylinders, and electricity. **Furthermore, more than 580 schools have been connected with toilet and water facilities.** 

Union Home Minister Shri Shah highlighted the internal conflicts within Congress over the CM position, particularly between Randeep Surjewala and Kumari Selja, as well as the senior and junior Hooda. Shri Shah then praised the BJP for its unity, noting that Shri Manohar Lal Khattar stepped down for a role at the Union government, allowing the party to promote a young leader like Shri Nayab Singh Saini without any infighting. There has been infighting in Congress regarding ticket distribution. Previous Haryana government under Congress focused on the district and caste of the elected CM, but now under BJP, CM serves all parts of Haryana, benefiting all 36 castes. BJP has developed four key groups: the poor, youth, farmers, and women. In Yamunanagar, projects worth ₹150 crore for roads connecting Kala Amb, Barada, and Shahabad, along with the approval of 11 highway constructions, have been initiated.

Shri Shah stated that **if the AICC President evaluates everything the party has done for Haryana since independence, the achievements of the BJP will stand out**. The party has decided to grant a GI tag to guava, making it accessible in the global market. Additionally, it will provide free coaching and hostels for OBC, SC, and EWS students. **A new medical college will be inaugurated**, **and Vishwakarma College will be established for skill development.** Hospitals with 100 beds will be upgraded to 200 beds for improved facilities. **A large modern Sabhagar will be constructed, considering the population's needs, and an Olympic nursery will be developed in the state**.

Union Home Minister Shri Shah announced that after the elections, every woman in Haryana will receive ₹2,100 directly in her bank account, as decided by Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi Ji. The BJP has decided to provide gas cylinders at a fixed price of ₹500, Fatehabad will be developed as a modern city similar to IMT Kharkhoda. Additionally, the free health benefits will increase from ₹5 lakh to ₹10 lakh and the government has decided to provide free health coverage of ₹15 lakh to elderly people above 70 years. BJP has undertaken the redevelopment

of the Karnal-Yamunanagar railway line, valued at ₹1,200 crore, and the Yamunanagar-Jagadhri railway station, worth ₹2,200 crore. Over ₹150 crore has been disbursed to 66,000 farmers. After re-electing CM Shri Nayab Singh Saini, the financial assistance to farmers will increase from ₹6,000 to ₹10,000. Under the PM Krishi Sinchai Yojana, production has increased across 17,000 hectares, with over 50,000 farmers registered under the 'Meri Fasal Mera Byora' scheme. Irrigation has improved for 5,500 farmers over 12,000 acres. The BJP has appointed a strong OBC CM, Shri Nayab Singh Saini, who has raised the creamy layer limit from ₹6 lakh to ₹8 lakh.

Shri Shah highlighted that two lakh government jobs will be provided to the youth, and five lakh will receive employment opportunities with a monthly stipend. We will construct five lakh houses, and every person's diagnosis and dialysis will be free. An Olympic nursery will be established in every district, and under the 'Aval Baalika Yojana,' every college-going girl will receive a scooty. Rahul Gandhi is misleading the youth about Agniveer, but let it be clear: the BJP promises that no Agniveer will be left behind. Everyone will receive a pension, and both the Haryana and central governments will ensure this. The Haryana government will provide a ₹25 lakh loan guarantee to OBC and SC students aspiring to pursue engineering and medical studies. The pension for widows, elderly, and disabled individuals has been increased to ₹3,000 per month. More than ₹4,000 in incentives have been offered to encourage farmers to grow oilseeds and pulses. The Atal Kisan Mazdoor canteen provides meals for just ₹10, and each farmer receives ₹2,000 per acre during rainfall. Those who missed the chance to engage in corruption over the past decade are now attempting to regain power. Such corrupt individuals should not be allowed to govern. The Congress party cannot ensure the state's development.

Union Home Minister Shri Shah stated that in the upcoming 5 years, an 800 MW new thermal power station will be constructed in Yamunanagar. A dedicated Mother and Child care hospital will also be established in the district, along with ICU facilities in civil hospitals. Ten industrial cities will be developed, including one in Yamunanagar. Dialysis and diagnostic services will be provided free of cost in every hospital. New Vande Bharat trains will be introduced, and the Aravali Jungle Safari will be launched. The Congress is only capable of promoting casteism, corruption, and nepotism. They cannot ensure security in Kashmir, Punjab, or the nation. Under the leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji's, a surgical and air strike was carried out within 10 days as a strong response to terrorism.

Hon'ble Union Home Minister Shri Shah stated that the Congress Party cannot provide corruption-free governance for Haryana and fails to respect farmers and Dalits. **The BJP has focused on the development of every village over the past 10 years**. Shri Shah urged the public to support the BJP for the next five years, emphasizing that with **Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi Ji at the center, the double-engine government will make Haryana the top state.** Shri Shah encouraged attendees to reach out to 10-25 people in Tohana, Ratia and Jagadhari to ensure their votes for the BJP before 12 PM.
