The BJP government freed Kaziranga, which had been handed over to infiltrators during the Congress rule.

The 10-year rule of the BJP in Assam has been a golden era for the state.

By signing 13 agreements, PM Modi brought over 10,000 youths into the mainstream after they laid down arms.

Assam, which gave the country a Prime Minister, received only ₹1.28 lakh crore in 10 years under Congress, whereas PM Modi allocated ₹9.35 lakh crore.

The Modi government carried out several historic tasks in Assam, including Asia's largest Bogibeel Bridge and the state's first semiconductor plant.

PM Modi also established an IIM and AIIMS, and undertook a ₹222 crore redevelopment of the birthplace of Mahapurush Srimanta Sankardev.

Assam, April 02, 2026: Honorable Union Minister of Home and Cooperation Shri Amit Shah addressed a massive public rally in Kaliabor and campaigned for NDA alliance partner AGP candidate Keshav Mahanta. Speaking on the occasion Shri Shah said that the NDA is going to form the government in Assam for the third consecutive term. He also appealed to the BJP karyakartas to put in more hard work to make the NDA partners winner than they would have done for BJP candidates. He also said that the last 10 years of NDA government in Assam was a golden period in the state's history.

Kaziranga is located nearby, and its rhinos have the potential to attract tourists to Assam from across the world. The Congress governments had handed over Kaziranga to infiltrators, whereas the Bharatiya Janata Party and Asom Gana Parishad governments freed its land and secured the rhinos—symbols of Assam's pride—while also promoting tourism.

Shri Shah said that the Congress party never did anything for the development of Assam. Rahul Gandhi had also visited Assam and made loud claims about achievements. He should answer—during the 15 years of Congress rule, what did they actually do for Assam? From 2004 to 2014, Congress was in power both in Assam and at the Centre under Dr. Manmohan Singh, yet only ₹1.28 lakh crore was allocated for Assam's

development. Assam gave the country a Prime Minister, yet it received just ₹1.28 lakh crore in return. In contrast, under our respected Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji, Assam received ₹9.78 lakh crore between 2014 and 2024 alone.

Infrastructure projects worth ₹1.35 lakh crore have been executed in Assam. Roads worth ₹30,000 crore were constructed, ₹95,000 crore was spent on railways, and ₹10,000 crore on airports. Alongside this, 9 medical colleges and several engineering colleges were established. Massive investments have been brought into Assam under the leadership of Chief Minister Shri Himanta Biswa Sarma and Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji. A ₹22,000 crore road connecting Meghalaya to Assam was built, the Gohpur–Numaligarh access controlled greenfield road was constructed at a cost of ₹18,662 crore, 443 km of roads were built under the Bharatmala project, and 3,700 km of rural roads were developed.

Asia's largest Bogibeel Bridge, carrying both rail and road traffic, was constructed during this period. A ₹6,000 crore bridge between Dhubri and Phulbari over the Brahmaputra River was built, the Dhola–Sadiya bridge was completed at a cost of ₹2,000 crore, and work is ongoing on a 6-lane bridge in Guwahati connecting both banks of the Brahmaputra.

The Union Home and Cooperation Minister said that the NDA government has developed waterways and taken several steps to boost tourism. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji brought India's first semiconductor plant to Assam with an investment of ₹27,000 crore. The establishment of Assam

Skill University, Tamulpur Medical College, Dhubri Medical College, a ₹188 crore regional centre of excellence in Dibrugarh, a ₹122 crore agricultural college in Patharkandi, and a ₹1,100 crore 750-bed AIIMS are all initiatives undertaken under his leadership. An IIM has also been established in Assam.

At Batadrava Than, the birthplace of Mahapurush Srimanta Sankardev, a grand Satra has been developed under a ₹222 crore redevelopment project. Congress only encouraged infiltration and tried to present the issue through a Hindu-Muslim lens. The BJP opposes infiltrators but has no opposition to indigenous Muslims of Assam. To preserve Assam's culture, a grand memorial was built in Guwahati in honour of the martyrs of the Assam Movement. An 85-foot statue of Lachit Borphukan has been installed, and his life story has been translated into 21 languages and spread across the country—from the Himalayas to Kerala and from Dwarka to Kamakhya.

Congress neither conferred the Bharat Ratna on Gopinath Bordoloi Ji nor on the great musician Bhupen Hazarika. It was Prime Minister Narendra Modi Ji who honoured Bhupen Hazarika with the Bharat Ratna. Assamese has been granted classical language status, and new avenues of development have been opened through roads, waterways, and ports across Assam. More than 13 peace accords have been signed, transforming Assam from a region once known for bomb blasts and violence into one moving towards peace. Over 10,000 youth have laid down arms and joined the mainstream under the NDA government.

Shri Shah said that the alliance between the Asom Gana Parishad and the BJP is as certain as the sun and the moon. Congress spreads rumours that this alliance will not last, but Rahul Gandhi need not indulge in wishful thinking. This alliance has worked successfully for the past 10 years and will continue for the next 15 years, with the elephant and the lotus moving forward together.

He urged all BJP, AGP, and NDA workers to treat the elephant symbol as the lotus and the lotus as the elephant, and move forward unitedly. The NDA government must be formed again for the next five years. Shri Himanta Biswa Sarma must be made Chief Minister once again, and the hands of Prime Minister Narendra Modi Ji must be strengthened further. The people of Kaliabor will ensure the victory of Shri Keshav Mahanta with an even larger margin than before and send him to the Assembly.

The coming five years are extremely important for Assam, especially for its youth, as they will shape not only the future of Assam but of India. Shri Amit Shah said that the people of Assam should prepare to celebrate the upcoming Bihu festival with enthusiasm, marking the victory of the lotus and the elephant.
