

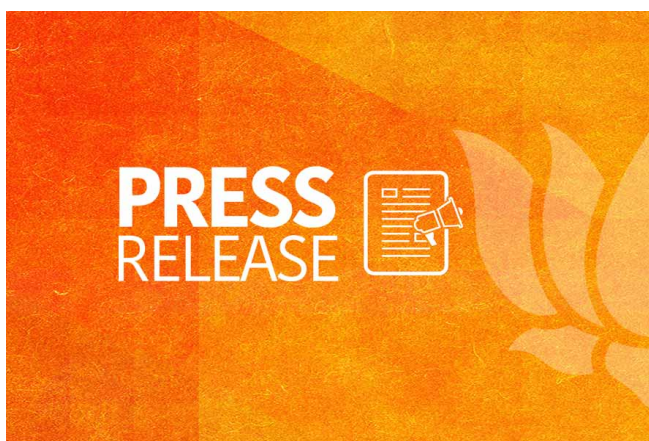

## **Press Release: Statement of Hon'ble Union Home Minister & Minister of Cooperation and senior BJP leader Shri Amit Shah**

**The Modi Government is Ready for Every Discussion in Parliament, but the Opposition's Objective is to Create a Ruckus, Not Hold a Discussion – Shri Amit Shah**

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**“I am ready to answer every question raised by the Opposition” – Shri Amit Shah**

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**“The people have to decide who wants a discussion and who is running away” – Shri Amit Shah**

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Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah today made it clear that the Modi Government is fully prepared for every kind of discussion in Parliament. He said that he is ready to answer any question in Parliament, but the Opposition does not want to allow a discussion to take place. Shri Amit Shah said that the Modi Government, led by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, and the Bharatiya Janata Party-led NDA are ready to discuss every issue; the Opposition should simply allow Parliament to function.

The Union Home Minister put forward a clear proposal before the Opposition, saying that if the Opposition submits a letter to the Hon'ble Speaker by 2 PM today seeking a discussion, the discussion can begin at 3 PM today and continue until 3 PM tomorrow. Shri Shah said that if the Hon'ble Speaker permits, the Government is even ready to suspend Question Hour so that a detailed discussion can take place from 3 PM today until late at night and continue until 3 PM tomorrow.

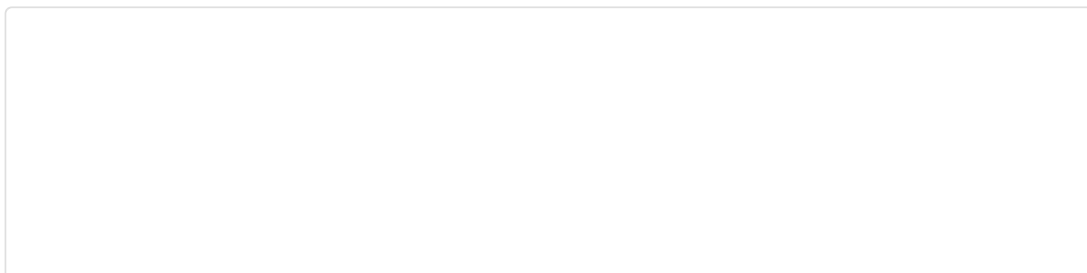
Shri Amit Shah said that he himself would remain present in the House, listen to everyone, note down every point, and answer each and every question raised by the Opposition at 3 PM tomorrow. He said that the Government has nothing to hide. Once a discussion takes place, everything will become clear before the people of the country—"the truth will emerge clearly."

Responding to the Opposition's demand, the Union Home Minister said that some people were asking him to simply make a statement, but such a serious matter cannot be addressed through a statement alone. He said that Parliament has established rules and procedures for holding discussions, and under parliamentary practice, matters are discussed at length. A statement will also be made in accordance with parliamentary conventions.

Shri Amit Shah said that since the beginning of the Parliament session, he has been going to Parliament regularly, but the Opposition has not been allowing Parliament to function in either House. He said that Parliamentary Affairs Minister Shri Kiren Rijiju has already made it clear on behalf of the Government that it is ready for every kind of discussion, provided time is allotted for the discussion and the Opposition is ready to participate. The Opposition had initially been making the same demand, and the Government has now agreed to it.

In conclusion, Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah said that it is now for the Opposition to decide whether it wants a discussion or a ruckus. The people will decide who wants to engage in a discussion and who is running away from it.

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
